## **Residual Bequest Language**

A residual bequest comes to us after your estate expenses and specific bequests are paid:

I give and devise to The Children's Hospital of San Antonio Foundation, located in San Antonio, TX, all (or state a percentage) of the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, both real and personal, to be used for its general support (or for the support of a specific fund or program).

## **Specific Bequest Language**

Naming The Children's Hospital of San Antonio Foundation as a beneficiary of a specific amount from your estate is easy:

I give and devise to The Children's Hospital of San Antonio Foundation, located in San Antonio, TX, the sum of \$\_\_\_\_\_ (or asset) to be used for its general support (or for the support of a specific fund or program).

## **Contingent Bequest Language**

The Children's Hospital of San Antonio Foundation can be named as a contingent beneficiary in your will or personal trust if one or more of your specific bequests cannot be fulfilled:
